

Breakfast Club

Opens at 7:45am and includes breakfast.

Cost per playgroup or school child: £4.00 per session

After School Care

Opens at 3.20pm or directly after an activity club.

Cost per school child:

£4.00 per session from 3:20pm - 4:30pm £8.00 per session from 3:20pm - 5:30pm £12.00 per session from 3:20pm - 6:00pm

£4.00 per session following after school activity from 4:15pm - 5:30pm £8.00 per session following after school activity from 4:15pm - 6:00pm

Cost per playgroup child:

£4.50 per session from 3:20pm - 4:30pm £9.00 per session from 3:20pm - 5:30pm £13.00 per session from 3:20pm - 6:00pm

Bookings or cancellations can be made online via SCO Pay. If you would like to use Wraparound Care for the first time or have not booked sessions recently please contact the school for access to the booking calendar: wookeywraparoundcare@educ.somerset.gov.uk

Bookings cannot be made online for the same day or the following day.

If you need to make a cancellation for the same day or the following day please contact us as we can remove the session and, where 24 hours notice is given, credit your account.

A Wraparound Care Agreement will need to be completed and handed in before the first session your child attends.
