Hot Lunches next week - Week 1



## School Admissions - September 2019

The online admissions process for school place applications in September 2019 is now live.

For children due to start school for the first time or transfer to a junior or middle school the closing date for applications is 15th January 2019 and the national offer day is 16th April 2019. For children due to transfer to a secondary or upper school the closing date for applications is 31st October 2018 and the national offer day is 1st March 2019.

## **Head lice**
